Professor Anne MacGregor gives tips for parents on how to recognise and treat headaches in children. Most children and teenagers get at least 1 headache a year. They're often different from the headaches that adults get, so parents and healthcare professionals can fail to notice the problem. Headaches, including migraines, tend to be much shorter in children, according to Professor MacGregor of the Centre for Neuroscience and Trauma at Barts and the London School of Medicine and Dentistry.

Headaches in children - NHS

Headaches in children are common and usually aren't serious. Like adults, children can develop different types of headaches, including migraines or stress-related (tension) headaches. Children can also have chronic daily headaches. In some cases, headaches in children are caused by an infection, high levels of stress or anxiety, or minor head trauma.

Headaches caused by a brain tumour: will usually be persistent, occurring on most days. will usually be accompanied by vomiting or another symptom. may wake the child up or occur particularly when they wake up. may make the child confused, disorientated, excessively tired, and/or they may be less alert/responsive at the same time as the headache. In this age group, some children will not be able to describe how they feel or may have difficulty.

Prevention of headaches in a child: Limit the amount of baby food products such as crisps, chocolate, nuts, oranges, cheese, because they contain large amounts of tyramine. Tyramine has the property of narrowing of the blood vessels, which leads to headaches. If your child is often a headache, use in the room dim, dim light.

If you do not need to go to hospital, you can usually look after yourself or your child at home. It's normal to have symptoms such as a slight headache, or feeling sick or dazed, for up to 2 weeks.
