Peripheral artery bypass is surgery to reroute the blood supply around a blocked artery in one of your legs. Fatty deposits can build up inside the arteries and block them. A graft is used to replace or bypass the blocked part of the artery.

The aim of coronary bypass surgery is to bypass -- or ' get around ' - the narrowed sections of your coronary arteries. The surgeon does this by grafting a blood vessel between the aorta (the main blood vessel leaving the heart) and a point along the coronary artery, past the narrowed area. In most cases, at least one of the blood vessels used as a bypass graft is an artery from your chest called the internal mammary artery.

For instance, if you have disease in the heart arteries, particularly if you are experiencing symptoms such as chest pains or shortness of breath, then it might be treated with an angioplasty and stent. Or if you have narrowings in multiple coronary arteries, you may be recommended to have coronary bypass graft surgery. Similarly, significant narrowings in the legs or pelvis arteries can be treated with angioplasty and stenting or occasionally bypass surgery.

Surgical Bypass: In people who have long blockages which cannot be treated adequately by angioplasty a bypass may be necessary. In this situation an operation is performed and a tube (either an artificial artery or a surface vein taken from the leg) is sewn onto the artery above and below the blockage.

The most common type of surgery to correct transposition when identified in babies is the arterial switch operation. During this operation, the surgeon moves the great arteries so they are connected to the correct pumping chamber. The arteries that supply the heart (coronary arteries) must also be moved.
